## December 2018

1. Sat – Linguae Christi – December is a busy time of year, but please commit afresh to pray for us! We have included scripture throughout this month to help prepare our hearts and keep us focused on Jesus. Thank you for praying!
2. Sun – Cymraeg (Welsh 1) – Please, pray for me as I'll be in Udine, Friuli for a Music/Cultural Festival and to make some in roads to prepare for some potential student teams next summer.
3. Mon – Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1) – Dec 2-7 we will host 20 returning missionaries for a debrief at the training center. Please pray as many will have experienced challenges on the field such as persecution, marriage issues, or team conflict and need time and space to process.
4. Tue – Cymraeg (Welsh 5) – Please pray for our non-believing Welsh friends who are celebrating Christmas this month but do not understand its true meaning. Pray that they would come to know and follow Jesus.
5. Wed – Cymraeg (Welsh 1) – Please, pray for me as I fly back from Venice to London, then train home to North Wales.
6. Thu – Linguae Christi – "The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them has light shone." Isaiah 9:2
7. Fri – Cymraeg (Welsh 3) – Choirs across Wales are singing about Jesus this month without knowing who He is. Please pray that God will speak to their hearts.
8. Sat – Cymraeg (Welsh 1) – Please, pray that the Lord would provide a vehicle for me to use for ministry, while I am in the USA for a month.
9. Sun – Cymraeg (Welsh 5) – Pray for me as I travel to meet with potential ministry support partners.

10. Mon – Linguæ Christi – Please pray for our friends who are planting a Basque speaking church. Pray that God provides for them and sustains them as they step out in faith.
11. Tue – Cymraeg (Welsh 1) – Please, pray for me as I fly to the USA for about a month of mobilisation and networking opportunities.
12. Wed – Linguæ Christi – "Every valley shall be lifted up, and every mountain and hill be made low; the uneven ground shall become level, and the rough places a plain. And the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together, for the mouth of the Lord has spoken." Isaiah 40:4-5
13. Thu – Cymraeg (Welsh 3) – Please pray for our two Bible studies for older boys and girls. Pray God will change their lives.
14. Fri – Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1) – Pray for God's Spirit to move among the Irish speakers in West Ireland. This time of year people hear more about Jesus than any other because of school plays and church programs. Yet it's often just a going through the motions with your village. Pray many will truly taste and see that the Lord is good.
15. Sat – Linguæ Christi – "Our God is merciful and tender. He will cause the bright dawn of salvation to rise on us and to shine from heaven on all those who live in the dark shadow of death, to guide our steps into the path of peace." Luke 1:78-79
16. Sun – Cymraeg (Welsh 1) – Please, pray for me as I have an opportunity to connect with local believers and Churches to share about our ministry.
17. Mon – Linguæ Christi – "The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it." John 1:5
18. Tue – Cymraeg (Welsh 5) – Pray for the Lord to bring people to partner with us who would share the vision for spreading the gospel in minority language groups throughout Europe.
19. Wed – Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1) – Pray for God to provide for our personal and ministry finance needs. 2018 has been a very difficult year in this area.
20. Thu – Cymraeg (Welsh 3) – Please pray God will give our families peace while we're away this Christmas season.
21. Fri – Linguæ Christi – "And she gave birth to her firstborn son and wrapped him in swaddling cloths and laid him in a manger, because there was no place for them in the inn." Luke 2:7
22. Sat – Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1) – In Ireland Christian ministries with overseas volunteers are still struggling through the visa process with much uncertainty. Pray for a clear and definite path for many to serve.

23. Sun – Linguæ Christi – “And the angel said to them, 'Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people.'" Luke 2:10
24. Mon – Cymraeg (Welsh 3) – Please pray that we will experience God's peace and hope during this season.
25. Tue – Linguæ Christi – "A child is born to us! A son is given to us! And he will be our ruler. He will be called, 'Wonderful Counselor,' 'Mighty God,' 'Eternal Father,' 'Prince of Peace.'" Isaiah 9:6
26. Wed – Cymraeg (Welsh 1) – Please, pray for me as I travel by car to St. Louis in Preparation for the Urbana Conference there.
27. Thu – Linguæ Christi – Simeon took the child in his arms and gave thanks to God:  
“Now, Lord, you have kept your promise, and you may let your servant go in peace. With my own eyes I have seen your salvation, which you have prepared in the presence of all peoples: A light to reveal your will to the Gentiles and bring glory to your people Israel.” John 2:28-32
