2. Wed – Cymraeg (Welsh 1) – Please pray for representatives of Linguæ Christi who will be exhibiting at the Cross Conference Student Missions Conference in Louisville, KY. Please pray for good conversations and connections.
3. Thu – Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1) – In January we will train at least 10 adults going to Europe to serve long term in Ireland, Spain, France and the Czech Republic. Pray they will develop a heart for and ministry strategy to reach the indigenous minority language groups in their communities.
4. Fri – Cymraeg (Welsh 3) – Thank God for a good visit with family over the holidays.
5. Sat – Cymraeg (Welsh 5) – Please pray for renewed focus as I come out of a busy holiday season with my family and get back into the rhythm of fundraising.
6. Sun – Euskara (Basque 1) – Please pray for guidance and direction of God for the first meetings of 2019 of the future community of faith in Basque.
7. Mon – Linguæ Christi – Pray that we comfort others well and encourage each other as a community of faith.
8. Tue – Cymraeg (Welsh 3) – Pray for Gospel conversations and for people to pay attention to the soul-hunger that many try to ignore and replace.

9. Wed – Cymraeg (Welsh 1) – Please pray for me as I fly out tonight from Nashville back to London. With all travel, I should be home in North Wales by the evening of the 11th, Lord willing.
10. Thu – Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1) – Pray for God's provision financially for training and placing new families in Europe.
11. Fri – Cymraeg (Welsh 3) – Pray for the church in town as they rethink gatherings with a creative and family-friendly focus in mind.
12. Sat – Cymraeg (Welsh 5) – Please pray that I would be diligent in my preparation and networking so that I can make my move to Wales this year.
13. Sun – Euskara (Basque 1) – Please pray for the personal growth of our son, especially for his language and social development.
14. Mon – Linguæ Christi – Pray as we seek innovative of ways of sharing God's Good News with groups who have yet to hear.
15. Tue – Cymraeg (Welsh 3) – Pray that we listen when God speaks.
