1. Mon – Cymraeg (Welsh 1) – Please, pray for me as I travel back from a few days of R&R.
2. Tue – Cymraeg (Welsh 1) – Please, pray for me, as I meet with area ministers in a local fraternal meeting.
3. Wed – Cymraeg (Welsh 2) – Please pray for balance in a busy month. We never want to be so busy that we can't stop and be with friends.
4. Thu – Euskara (Basque 1) – Please pray for the next meeting of the Community of faith in Euskara in the town of Usurbil. (Sunday, April 7)
5. Fri – Cymraeg (Welsh 3) – Please pray for me as I am spending the weekend leading a group of students at a retreat. Pray that it would be a time of encouragement and growth.
6. Sat – Cymraeg (Welsh 1) – It is now “crunch time” to have students to sign up for summer projects. We’ve made a lot of contacts at two big student Missions Conferences just before and right after New Year’s, as well as a recent visit with a number students, while in California. Pray that God will continue to call out some of them to serve with us this summer.
7. Sun – Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1) – Please pray for a family in training with us who will serve with an indigenous people group in northeastern Spain.
8. Mon – Cymraeg (Welsh 3) – Please pray that I raise enough monthly support to attend pre-field training next month.
9. Tue – Cymraeg (Welsh 2) – Pray for a couple who have joined us for a week as they weigh and pray about joining our team long-term.

10. Wed – Euskara (Basque 1) – Please pray for the 5 people that are serving God in the production company in Basque of Kale Argia.
11. Thu – Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1) – Please pray for a young man in training with us who will serve with an indigenous people group in Russia.
12. Fri – Cymraeg (Welsh 4) – Please begin praying for the National Eisteddfod (annual Welsh language & culture festival) which will be hosted by Conwy, our home county in August. Pray for the planning of opportunities to share the gospel during this important week in Welsh life and culture.

18. Thu – Cymraeg (Welsh 3) – Please pray for this month to present opportunities for our team to share the Gospel with our friends as we celebrate Easter.
19. Fri – Cymraeg (Welsh 4) – Please pray for the young people's summer camp I'll be leading in Bala in August. We had a training day for the camp officers last month. Pray for the officers as they begin to prepare for the young people they'll be investing in this summer.
20. Sat – Euskara (Basque 1) – Please for the provision of economic support for our family during this year.
21. Sun – Cymraeg (Welsh 1) – Please, pray for me as I preach in Caersalem Chapel in Caernarfon this Easter evening.
22. Mon – Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1) – Pray for God's provision for all the LC families as we raise financial support to serve full time.
23. Tue – Cymraeg (Welsh 2) – Pray for encouragement among believers this week and pray against envy of each other and the gifts God has given us.

24. Wed – Cymraeg (Welsh 3) – Pray for a renewed energy in this busy spring season.
