1. Dydd Gŵyl Ddewi Hapus / Happy St. David's Day! Today we encourage you to "do the little things" by remembering us in prayer each day. 2. Cymraeg (Welsh 1) – Pray for students and those of us recruiting for the summer student projects in the latter half of the summer this year.
3. Lëtzebuergesch (Luxembourgish 1) – Please pray for changed lives through reading the newly published version of the New Testament in Luxembourgish. Praise the Lord as well for all the stories of positive responses so far.
4. Cymraeg (Welsh 2) – Pray for our son—that he grows to be a man formed by God's love.
5. Gool Peran Lowen / Happy St. Piran's Day! Here's a song from Gwenno, whose latest album was entirely in Cornish. Join us as we pray for Cornish speakers and for God's voice in their communities.
6. Cymraeg (Welsh 3) – Pray for churches and individuals considering and planning trips to work with us over the summer.
7. Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1) – I will lead some important meetings at CIT on 11-12 March. Pray for wisdom and God's direction in our decisions and planning.
8. Euskara (Basque 1) – Please pray for the health of our child.
9. Cymraeg (Welsh 2) – Pray that God gives us perseverance in the midst of struggles, and in so doing forms the character of Christ in us, our hope of glory.
10. Cymraeg (Welsh 3) – Please pray that I would have enough funding to apply for my visa in the next couple of weeks.

11. Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1) – Pray as I coordinate the pre-field training in March for workers who will soon depart for their fields of service. Pray for energy, insight, and my own spiritual walk.
12. Euskara (Basque 1) – Please pray for the meetings of the Euskalduna faith community in Usurbil on Sunday, March 15 and 29.
13. Galego (Galician 1) – Pray for our brothers and sisters in Galicia who are exploring how they can work out their faith in their heart language, Galego.
14. Euskara (Basque 1) – Pray for our Basque Country friends.
15. Català (Catalan 1) – Please pray for us as we give a presentation in the main hall of Teatre-Cinema del Poble in our town. Pray that our testimony would be in line with God’s direction.
16. Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1) – Our children continue to have Gospel opportunities in the community. Please pray the Spirit draws their friends to himself and that our kids have wisdom on how to discuss spiritual matters with them.
17. Lá fhéile Pádraig sona daoibh / Happy St. Patrick's Day! Here's a beautiful version of The Parting Glass sung in Irish to help you celebrate the day. Join us as we pray for Irish speakers and the Gospel in their midst.
18. Cymraeg (Welsh 2) – Pray for the kids in our village. There are so many different cares and concerns that affect their lives from day-to-day. We just want them to know that God loves them—that's enough to change their lives.
19. Cymraeg (Welsh 1) – Please, pray for me today as I will be attending the Spring Prayer Retreat of the Evangelical Alliance of the UK in London.
20. Lëtzebuergesch (Luxembourgish 1) – Please pray for the newly started work of translating the Old Testament into Luxembourgish, so that the full Bible will be available to Luxembourgish speakers in their heart language.
21. Euskara (Basque 1) – Pray for the new book my wife is writing about biblical devotions.
22. Cymraeg (Welsh 3) – Please pray for the continued process of reconciliation of my relationship with a member of my family.
23. Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1) – Pray that God will provide a new generation of trainers in the years to come. In order to impact younger workers, we need those coming off the field to volunteer to train using their experiences and insights.
24. Cymraeg (Welsh 1) – Please, pray for me as I attend the regular meeting of the Executive of the Evangelical Alliance of Wales in Cardiff today.

25. Cymraeg (Welsh 2) – Pray that we can support local Christians in their kingdom endeavours. We want to be useful and encouraging, but we also want to challenge and exhort our sisters and brothers to trust God in every situation.
26. Euskara (Basque 1) – Pray for wisdom to make decisions.
27. Cymraeg (Welsh 1) – Please, pray for me tomorrow morning, Saturday the 28th. I have been invited by the Church of Scotland to speak at their Conference “An Ath Cheum” (the second step), regarding the work of Linguae Christi, and how it relates to Scottish Gaelic. The An Ath Cheum Conference is looking at the role of Scottish Gaelic in Church life and growth among speakers of the language.
